The September 15, 2025, Olivet Church Board Meeting was called to order by President Karen Broz at 7:02 pm. Reverend Natalie opened the meeting with a prayer.

The minutes for August 2025 were reviewed and approved as written.

Financial Reports

The Financial Reports for August 2025 were presented by Diane Bartley. The Balance Sheet, Cash on Hand Reports, and the Budget vs Actual for August 2025 were reviewed. Chris Valleroy made a motion to approve the financial report. Mary Dewey seconded, the motion passed.

Finance Committee Report.

- Finance Report Ken Bartley and Jason Enright
 - August was tough month for expenses, but an average month for income
 - ♦ Property expenses were up this month.
 - Prepaid pledges are up 43% compared to end of August last year.
- 2026 Budget Ken Bartley. Motion made to approve budget with corrections by Ken Bartley and seconded by Mary Dewey, passed.
 - ♦ 2026 budget shows a 3.4% increase over 2025
 - Increases were made in the sabbatical allowances were made for both pastors.
 - The Property Team has proposed a 22% increase in the 2026 budget. Much of this increase is related to snow and ice removal.
- Personnel Budget Rob Foss.
 - Performance reviews have been completed
 - ♦ Budget provides a cost-of-living increase of 5%
 - The 2026 budget also adds a fifth Sunday off for both pastors in 2026. Motion made to approve by Chris Valleroy, seconded by Marty Albrecht, motion passed.
 - ♦ Pastor Hannah is planning for a sabbatical in 2026.

Minister Reports

Reverend Natalie Dixon Crewell.

- Lots of pastoral care activities. Shepherds are playing a major role.
- Visioning team is working on new vision items.
- Grace Expansion Team is forming.
- Going to Phoenix with Hannah in November for a preaching conference.
- Natalie will leave for vacation soon

Reverend Hannah Ryan

- New Sunday School classes started Sept. 14. Background checks for all teachers are complete
- Natalie and Amanda Durbak started the faith and human sexuality class Sept. 14
- The new sensory space is useable, but there is some additional work to complete.
- Working on this year's Advent theme.
- Hannah plans to take some time off Oct. 6-12.

- Slate of board members and Trustees for 2026: motion made by Joyce Mast and seconded by Marty Albrecht to approve the slate as presented and approve by email the person to fill the open position, motioned passed

 - ♦ Bob Moore (3 year term)
 - Open (3 year term) (update, Rockie Alden later accepted the nomination and was approved by an email vote)
 - ♦ Ginny Edgar (2 year term to finish out Jason Enright's term)
 - ♦ Trustees:
 - ◆ Angela Reeder (replaces Richard Edgar whose term is up – 5 year term)
 - Mike Alden (finishing out Chester Edwards term ending December 2027)
- Recommendation for equipment for accessibility for hearing impaired – motion made by Joyce Mast and seconded by Chris Valleroy, passed
 - New equipment will host a phone app that sends sound directly to a person's hearing aid.

- Purchase two more headphone devices for people who may not have a cell phone.
- Letter to Crossways Church re: parking motion to send letter regarding guidelines on parking, communication methods, and safety issues made by Joyce Mast and seconded by Marty Albrecht, passed
 - There have been several miscommunications in the past that they have been made aware of.
 - Discussion included several ideas of how to address these issues.
 - On give Crossways the option to build a foot path.
 - ♦ Include a statement explaining why we do not want them walking through the cemetery.
 - Suggest they work with Olivet Property Team to develop solutions and address safety concerns.

The board meeting adjourned at 8:14 pm.

In gratitude ...

The recent Sustainable Living Team program – 'Building Skills, Confidence and Community' – clearly demonstrated the many ways the Food Bank Market benefits our community. It provides nutritious food for persons in need in Boone County and so much more. Persons can shop at the Market once a month but can access food items available in the Sharing Room as many times as needed. The Market provides grocery delivery through DoorDash to neighbors within a 10-mile radius who have mobility issues or transportation challenges. They also provide Senior Boxes and Veteran Boxes for persons who qualify and provide Share-Packs – easy-to-carry bags that provide nutrition support and hygiene projects especially designed to help unhoused neighbors.

The Market also provides recipes and cooking demonstrations showcasing nutritious meals that can be prepared with foods available at the Market. Staff can also help shoppers connect with other community resources to enable them to become more self-sufficient. Learn more about the Market at https://sharefoodbringhope.org/the-food-bank-market/

Battle High School students with diverse support needs not only gain confidence while developing practical vocational skills, they contribute to the operation of the Market by re-packaging bulk food items in the warehouse or bagging groceries at the counter. They also develop problemsolving skills and gain satisfaction in knowing that their work really matters.

Our thanks to Sarah Frost for her work with these students and for facilitating this program for us and to Chelsea Tatlow for sharing the many ways the Market nourishes our community.

CROP Walk Support 2025

THANK YOU for your gracious support of our 2025 CROP WALK!

WALK DAY featured 18 Teams and 114 walkers who reported 1,123 miles walked in solidarity with our effort. Since WALK Day, 603 high-protein food items have been distributed to our 4 Columbia food partners.

Donations as of October 15th have now topped \$22,000 toward our goal of \$30,000. This amount includes \$418.13 from Shakespeare's Pizza – the largest amount we've received from a 15% Pizza fundraiser on WALK Day.

Olivet fielded a team of 13 walkers including Chris & Lori Valleroy and Garner Crewell who served as 'Can Wranglers' again this year, plus Linda Graue, Natalie Dixon Crewell, Pauli Landhuis, Linda Reed Brown, and Larry Brown, our featured concert performer, Dennis Bettenhausen and Laura Gust who posted our Storyboard signs, Marilyn Bettenhausen and Helen & Patrick Atkinson, friends of the Bettenhausens. Olivet folks reported 245 miles and supplied 55 food items. As of October 7th, Olivet members & friends have contributed \$3,465 toward our goal of \$5,000.
